3. Welcome New VP for Research, Dr. Meredith Bond

4. Office of Research Update
  - a. Graduate Faculty Research Support Program
    - The Office of Research received two applications for the month of October
    - 40% of available funds have been spent to date
    - URC members are reminded to encourage their colleagues to apply for GFSRP funding. Funds are distributed on a rolling basis as long as funds are available.
  - b. Academic Server
    - Funding to upgrade academic server was approved by David Jewell on October 11
    - Project kickoff meeting was held on November 2
    - Scope is to replace research aspects of Academic server (not classroom/teaching resources)
    - Target for launch date of site is late January/early February 2022

5. Grant Tuition Program

- The Office of Research has re-instated the Graduate Tuition Program
- The purpose of the program is to grow and promote research
- Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis
- The Office of Research has already received several applications for this program

6. Internal Awards: Open Discussion

a. FRD Evaluation Criteria Revision

- The revised rubric will be circulated to URC members via email, and URC members will need to indicate whether or not they support these changes
