CLEVELAND STATE UNIVERSITY INVITATION TO BID ("ITB") INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION

- 1. Bids must be received by CSU prior to the ITB due date/time as stated on the cover page of this ITB (as determined by the Time and day received in email box noted) the signature page and certification page must be signed in ink by an authorized representative and dated. Original signatures must be included with the "original" copy. Bids received after the ITB due date/time will not be considered. Office hours for receipt of Bids are Monday through Friday, 8AM to 5PM ET, except University observed holidays.
- 2. Bids are requested on the materials or services specified. Instructions, manufacturer's model or catalogue numbers, etc., where shown herein, are for descriptive purposes only and to guide the Bidder in interpretation of the quality, design, and performance desired, and shall not be construed to exclude Bids based on furnishing other types of material or service. If the description of your offer differs in any way, you must give complete detailed description in your Bid including pictures and literature where applicable. Unless specific exception is made, assumption will be that you are offering exactly as specified by this ITB. The University shall be the sole judge of the acceptability of any alternate material or service.
- 3. All prices MUST BE FIRM. Check your Bid carefully, for it may not be corrected after the ITB due date/time. Bidder will be expected to deliver at prices(s) bid. Unless otherwise stated, all Bids shall remain firm for a minimum period of sixty (60) days after the ITB opening date. Beyond sixty (60) days Bidder will have the option to honor the Bid or make a written request to withdraw the Bid from consideration.
- 4. The University reserves the right to award by item, by groups of items, or as a whole, whichever is deemed most advantageous to the University.
- 5. Unit prices govern the award. Unless specifically exempted, unit prices must be entered and item total extended on each item.
- 6. Bids are requested F.O.B. Destination. Prices bid are to include all charges for transportation, packaging, crates, containers, insurance, etc., necessary to complete delivery on an F.O.B. Destination basis.
- 7. Cleveland State University, a public institution of higher education and an instrumentality of the State of Ohio, is exempt from Ohio Sales Tax and Federal Excise Tax, including Federal Transportation Tax. Exemption certificates will be furnished upon request.
- 8. The University will consider using any cash discounts offered; however, only discounts for more than 30 days will be considered in computing the net figure of your Bid.
- 9. No Bid will be accepted that is not dated and signed in ink in the proper spaces provided. Your bid form will be accepted only if CSU's is dated and signed with reference to yours as an enclosure. Any Bid that does not include all requested information in accordance with the ITB may be considered not responsive.
- 10. For ITBs that require a mandatory pre-bid meeting, in the event that fewer than two potential bidders attend, the meeting may be rescheduled and the ITB due date extended if deemed necessary.
- 11. If you are unable to submit a Bid, please date and sign the ITB, indicate "No Bid", give a brief explanation, and return the ITB before the due date/time. Failure to extend this courtesy may jeopardize your consideration for receiving future ITBs.

- 12. Any samples requested must be furnished at Bidder's expense, and, if not destroyed by testing or required as future quality standard on items shipped, will upon timely request be returned at the Bidder's expense. Samples must clearly identify the Bidder, the ITB #, and the item the sample represents in the Bid. The University reserves the right to mutilate or destroy any sample if considered necessary for testing purposes. The University may keep the sample(s) of the Bidder awarded the contract until completion of the contract. Unsolicited samples submitted in response to this ITB will not be evaluated and the University may dispose of them in any way it chooses.
- 13. The Bidder agrees that it will keep confidential the features of any equipment, tools, gauges, patterns, designs, drawings, engineering data or other technical or proprietary information furnished by the University and use such items only in the production of items awarded as a result of this ITB and not otherwise, unless the University's written consent is first obtained. Upon demand or completion of any resultant purchase order, Bidder shall return all such items to the University or make other disposition thereof as may be directed or approved, in writing, by the University.
- 14. The Bidder, by submitting its Bid, agrees that any cost incurred by the Bidder in responding to this ITB, or in support of activities associated with this ITB, is to be borne by the Bidder and shall not be billed to the University. The University will incur no obligation or liability whatsoever to anyone by reason of issuance of this ITB, or action by anyone relative thereto.
- 15. The Bidder warrants that in submitting a Bid and in the performance of any resulting purchase order award, Bidder has complied with and will continue to comply with all applicable Federal, State and Local Laws and Ordinances and University policies and procedures. Any purchase order awarded as a result of this ITB will be subject to all applicable laws and regulations and University policies and procedures.
- 16. The University reserves the right to reject any or all Bids or portions thereof, and to waive any informalities or irregularities in the Bids received.
- 17. Unless the University elects to reject all Bids and/or cancel this ITB, the University shall award the contract to the lowest cost-responsive and responsible Bidder. A Bidder is lowest if its Bid offers the lowest cost supply or service in comparison to all other Bidders. While Bidders may offer discounts for prompt payment and other similar incentives, such discounts and incentives will not be used to determine the lowest Bidder. When discounts are offered the discount will be calculated from the date the University receives a proper invoice, or the date the service is delivered and accepted in accordance with the University's Terms and Conditions. A Bid will be considered responsive if it meets the ITB in all material respects and contains no irregularities or deviations that would affect the amount of the Bid or otherwise give the Bidder a competitive advantage. The University's determination of a Bidder's responsibility may include, without limitation, the following factors: quality of the Bidder's work, experience in the field, conduct and performance of the Bidder on previous contracts, Bidder's ability to execute the contract properly, Bidder's financial condition, Bidder's management skills, Bidder's facilities.
- 18. All information supplied in response to this ITB is subject to verification. Misleading and inaccurate information may be grounds for disqualification at any stage in the evaluation and procurement process.
- 19. The contents of Bids submitted by the successful Bidder will be considered contractual obligations. Failure to meet these obligations may result in cancellation of any award made, and/or monetary claims being made by the University.
- 20. The University reserves the right not to select any of the Bids submitted for any reason at the University's discretion.
- 21. Ohio Revised Code ("ORC") 9.24 prohibits the University from awarding a contract to any person against whom the Auditor of the State has issued a finding for recovery if the finding for recovery is deemed "unresolved" at the time of award. By submitting a Bid, the Bidder warrants that it is not now, and will not become subject to an "unresolved"

finding for recovery under ORC 9.24 prior to or during the award of any contract arising out of this ITB, without notifying the University of such finding. If this warranty is false, any agreement resulting from this ITB, is void *ab initio*, and the Bidder must immediately repay to the University any funds paid under any such agreement.

- 22. The University may request clarification or additional information, including demonstrations, presentations, and further discussions, to evaluate a Bidder's responsiveness to the ITB or to evaluate a Bidder's responsibility. If a Bidder does not provide the requested information, it may adversely impact the University's evaluation of the Bidder's responsiveness or responsibility.
- 23. A Bidder may withdraw its Bid at any time prior to the ITB due date/time by written request to the University contact listed on the cover page of the ITB. Arrangements for the return of a withdrawn Bid may be made with the Purchasing Department and at the expense of the Bidder.
- 24. Questions will be answered and posted to the CSU Purchasing website 48 hours after the due date for the questions, in the form of an addendum. Bidders are prohibited from contacting any individual at, or associated with, CSU regarding this ITB other than the contact named on the cover page of this ITB. A Bidder's failure to adhere to this prohibition may, at CSU's sole discretion, disqualify the Bidder.
- 25. Only information contained in this ITB or written addendum/addenda issued by CSU are to be considered in preparing Bids. No verbal interpretations, changes or modifications are to be considered. The Bidder understands and agrees that it is the Bidder's duty to explain and clarify any and all conditions imposed on, or included in, its Bid. The Bidder also understands and agrees that the Bidder has the duty to inquire about, and clarify statements that are not fully understood or that the Bidder reasonably believes may be susceptible to more than one interpretation.
- 26. Bidders are required to comply with all of the terms and conditions of this ITB, whether the Bidder had actual knowledge of the terms and conditions of the ITB and regardless of any statement or omission in the Bid that might indicate a Bidders' contrary intention. The University will not agree to any additional or inconsistent terms or conditions proposed by the Bidder. The terms and conditions of the ITB prevail over any inconsistent or additional terms or conditions of the bid proposed by bidder.
- 27. Interested Bidders may attend the opening of the Bids. To protect the integrity of the ITB process, Bids will be closed for public review once the evaluation and award process begins. All Bids and other submitted materials shall be the property of CSU, will not be returned, and may become a public record pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 149.43. All proprietary information, which is clearly identified as such, disclosed to the University shall, to the extent permitted by law, be held in confidence and used only in the selection process for the ITB and in the development of any contract resulting from the RFP process, except as CSU is otherwise permitted by written instructions from the Bidder. Bidders shall be solely responsible for protecting their own trade secrets or proprietary information and will be responsible for all costs associated with protecting such information from disclosure. Prices, makes, models, catalog numbers of items offered, deliveries and terms of payment shall not be considered confidential.
- 28. Bidders must comply with all CSU policies while on campus, including but not limited to the tobacco free campus policy found at this link http://www.csuohio.edu/tobacco-free/tobacco-free-campus-policy
- 29. The University's Terms and Conditions shall govern any Purchase Order or contract issued as a result of this ITB.

TERMS & CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO ALL UNIVERSITY PURCHASES

- 1. Vendor shall acknowledge order(s) promptly, advising shipping date. The written order sent by University to vendor is subject to cancellation by University without notice if not accepted by vendor within fourteen days of issuance.
- 2. The University's Purchase Order and these Terms and Conditions, together with any specifications, schedules, exhibits, or other writings that may be attached or incorporated by reference, set forth the complete and final agreement between the University and the vendor with respect to the subject matter of the purchase. No amendments or modifications of or supplements to the provisions of the Purchase Order will be valid and binding upon the University unless in writing and signed by an authorized representative of the University. Vendor is deemed on notice that the University objects to any additional or different terms and conditions contained in any quotation, acknowledgment, invoice, or other communication from vendor, notwithstanding University's acceptance or payment for any delivery of goods and/or services, or any similar act by University. Any such proposed terms shall be void and the terms herein shall constitute the complete and exclusive statement of the terms and conditions of the contract between the parties. Vendor's acceptance or, at the election of the University, vendor's commencement of performance of the Purchase Order shall constitute acceptance by vendor of all of the terms and conditions of a University Purchase Order.
- 3. Vendor understands and agrees that University is a public institution of higher education and an instrumentality of the State of Ohio created pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 3344, and is subject to the Ohio Public Records Act, Ohio Revised Code §149.43, et seq., and that any record kept by University, which is deemed a public record is subject to release if a proper request is made.
- 4. Goods and services procured by University are exempt from Ohio sales tax (Ohio Revised Code Section 5739.02), and from federal excise tax (exemption no 34 730221f; Federal tax id 34-0966056).
- 5. By acceptance of University's Purchase Order, vendor hereby certifies to University its compliance with the Ohio Ethics Laws and further certified that all applicable parties listed in the Ohio Campaign Finance Law, Ohio Revised Code Section 3517.13, are in full compliance with Ohio Revised Code Section 3517.13.
- 6. Vendor represents and warrants the following:
 - a. Vendor is not subject to an "unresolved" finding for recovery under Ohio Revised Code Section 9.24 and further agrees that if this warranty is false, the Purchase Order shall be void ab initio and the vendor shall immediately repay to University any funds paid under this Purchase Order or an action for recovery may be immediately commenced by University for recovery of said funds.
 - b. Vendor and all of the entities and individuals acting on Vendor's behalf in connection with the goods and/or services provided hereunder, possesses and, at all times during the term of this Agreement shall possess, all qualifications and credentials required for performance of the Contract (including, without limitation, any licenses, certifications, or other credentials required by federal, state and/or local governmental authorities, and shall furnish documentation thereof within five (5) days of written request by University.
- 7. Vendor may not substitute or accept any alteration to a Purchase Order without written authority from the Purchasing Department. Correspondence or contacts pertaining to this order must be with the Purchasing Department.

- 8. Vendor shall indemnify and hold harmless Cleveland State University, its trustees, agents and employees from and against any and all demands, losses, liabilities, damages, judgments, costs and expenses (including but not limited to attorney's fees and costs related to data breaches and notification events), actions, and claims (including but not limited to claims of negligence), caused by or relating to the injury or death of any person, including but not limited to, vendor's employees and agents, or damage or loss or destruction to property of any person, arising out of or incident to the goods and/or services to be provided hereunder. Vendor shall not be held responsible for any losses, liabilities, costs, expenses, actions or claims directly, solely, and proximately caused by the negligence of Cleveland State University.
- 9. Vendor shall place on file with the Purchasing Department copies of Worker's Compensation coverage as required by Ohio State law, commercial general liability ("CGL") insurance and commercial automobile insurance (if vendor will use vehicles in the performance of work) prior to any work being done or services being rendered. Vendor shall maintain such required liability insurance coverage's with a limit of not less than \$1,000,000.00 each occurrence. If such CGL insurance contains a general aggregate limit, it shall apply separately to each project. CGL insurance shall be written on ISO occurrence form CG00 01 (or a substitute form providing equivalent coverage) and shall cover liability arising from operations, independent contractors, product-completed operations, personal injury and advertising injury, and liability assumed under an insured contract (including the tort liability of another assumed in a business contract).
- 10. All goods and/or services delivered hereunder shall be received subject to University's inspection and approval, and payment therefore shall not constitute acceptance thereof. All payments are subject to adjustment for shortage or rejection. All defective or non-conforming goods will be returned pursuant to the vendor's instruction at vendor's expense. To the extent that the Purchase Order requires a series of performances by vendor, University prospectively reserves the right to cancel the entire remainder of the Purchase Order if goods and/or services provided early in the term of the Purchase Order are non-conforming or otherwise rejected by University.
- 11. All blueprints, drawings, artwork or similar items prepared or constructed by vendor and paid for by University shall be University's property. Upon request of the University, and upon the completion of deliveries under the Purchase Order, or in case of the cancellation of the Purchase Order for any reason, vendor agrees to deliver to University all blueprints, drawings, or similar items, which may have been either furnished or paid for by University.
- 12. The University will not be responsible for goods delivered without a Purchase Order, or written authorization from the University Purchasing Department.
- 13. On all invoices subject to discount, the discount period will be calculated from the date correct invoice is received or goods and/or services are received, whichever is later.
- 14. Vendor must provide goods and/or services F.O.B. destination and must be suitably packed and prepared to secure the lowest transportation rates and to comply with all carrier regulations. No charges will be paid by University for packing, crating, or cartage unless otherwise specifically stated in the Purchase Order. Unless otherwise provided in the Purchase Order, no invoices shall be issued nor payments made prior to delivery. Unless freight and other charges are itemized, any discount will be taken on the full amount of invoice.
- 15. All shipments shall be fully insured unless otherwise stated.
- 16. The Purchase Order is subject to all applicable State of Ohio and Federal laws and regulations and University policies.
- 17. Terms and Conditions Relating to Federally Funded Purchase Orders. It is understood that by accepting a University Purchase Order, vendor agrees to comply with the following: the Equal Opportunity Act, Copland "Anti-

Kickback" Act, Davis-Bacon Act, contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act, Clean Air Act, Federal Water Pollution Act, Byrd anti-Lobbying Amendment, and Debarment and Suspension (E.O.s 12459 and 12689); 41 CFR 60-300.5(d), regulation prohibiting discrimination against qualified protected veterans; and 41 CFR 60-741.5(d), regulation prohibiting discrimination against qualified individuals on the basis of disability.

- 18. In the event that prevailing wage applies, invoices will not be honored unless prevailing wage rate forms are completed in entirety, signed by an authorized vendor representative, and returned to the University's Prevailing Wage coordinator. The following <u>signed</u> statement shall appear on all invoices: "I certify prevailing wages were paid in accordance with Section 4115 of the Ohio Revised Code".
- 19. Time for delivery of goods or performance of services under the Purchase Order is of the essence. Failure of vendor to meet delivery schedules or deliver within a reasonable time, as interpreted solely by University, shall constitute sufficient cause for University, at its option, to terminate the Purchase Order, in whole or in part and to charge vendor for any damages or losses the University may sustain as a result of vendor's default. Any failure by University to exercise this option with respect to any installment shall not constitute waiver with respect to subsequent installments. In the event vendor becomes insolvent or makes a transfer for the benefit of creditors in bankruptcy or any other insolvency proceedings are instituted by or against vendor, University shall have the right to immediately terminate the Purchase Order.
- 20. Vendor expressly warrants that all goods and/or services covered by the Purchase Order will conform to the specifications, drawings, samples, and other descriptions furnished or specified by the University, and will be of satisfactory material and quality production, free from defects and sufficient for the purpose intended. In addition to any other remedies the University may have, the University may reject goods and/or services not conforming to the foregoing warranties, whether or not the University shall have previously accepted such goods and/or services or any prior payment made thereon. If such goods and/or services are rejected, the University shall notify vendor in writing, and the University, at its option and at the expense and risk of vendor, may either return such rejected goods and/or services to vendor or hold them for such disposal as vendor shall indicate, without notice to any other person whatever. Any payment made on such rejected goods and/or services shall immediately be refunded to the University. Goods shall be delivered free from any security interest or other lien, encumbrance or claim of any third party. These warranties shall survive inspection, acceptance, passage of title and payment by University.
- 21. The Purchase Order is governed by the laws of the State of Ohio, without reference to any choice of laws rules and only Ohio courts shall have jurisdiction over any action or proceeding concerning the Purchase Order and/or performance thereunder.
- 22. In fulfilling the terms of the Purchase Order, vendor shall not discriminate, by reason of race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, age, disability, military status, national origin, or ancestry against any citizen of this State in the employment of any person qualified and available to perform the work.
- 23. No vendor providing goods and/or services to University shall advertise the fact that it has contracted with University for goods and/or services, or appropriate or make use of University's name or other identifying marks or property without the prior written consent of University's Marketing Department.
- 24. Except as otherwise provided in Section 1 above, the Purchase Order may be terminated at any time by University upon 30 days prior written notice to the vendor. The Purchase Order may be terminated immediately by University for breach by vendor of the Purchase Order, provided that University has provided vendor with notice of such breach and vendor has failed to cure within 10 days of receipt of such notice.

- 25. Vendor agrees that it will keep confidential all information regarding the features of any equipment, tools, gauges, patterns, designs, drawings, engineering data or other technical or proprietary information furnished by the University and will use such items only in the production of goods and/or services under the Purchase Order. Upon the completion or termination of the Purchase Order, vendor shall immediately return all confidential information to University or shall make other disposition of the confidential information as directed by University.
- 26. Vendor may not assign the Purchase Order, nor any money due or to become due without the prior written consent of University. Any assignment made without such consent shall be deemed void.
- 27. Failure of University to act immediately in response to a breach of the Purchase Order shall not be deemed a waiver of any default by vendor.
- 28. Neither University nor vendor shall be responsible for any delay or failure in performance resulting from any cause beyond their control, including without limitation, war, strikes, civil disturbances and acts of God. When vendor has knowledge of any actual or potential force majeure or other conditions that will delay or threatens to delay timely performance of the Purchase Order, vendor shall immediately give notice thereof, including all relevant information with respect to steps vendor is taking to complete delivery of the goods and/or services to University. Any such delay or failure shall give the University the right, at its option, to cancel all or such portion of the Purchase Order.
- 29. All notices under the Purchase Order shall be sent to the respective addresses on the face page of the Purchase Order by certified mail, return receipt requested, by overnight courier service, or by personal delivery and will be deemed effective upon receipt. In the event an addressee refuses to accept delivery, however, then notice shall be deemed to have been served on the date of said refusal of delivery. A party may change its address for notice by written notice by complying with this section.
