RFP #5033ME, CSU ELECTRIC SUPPLY CONTRACT

1. Is Cleveland State University signing the Suppliers Contracts?
CSU will execute the winning supplier(s)' agreements, subject to compliance with Ohio law and Cleveland State University policy.
2. Does Cleveland State University want Suppliers to submit their Contracts with the RFP Response for review?
No.
3. Does the University anticipate awarding on March 4th, 2025? If so, is there a time in which that selection would be made? How long is the supplier expected to hold their price?
No – pricing is not expected to be held. CSU will not execute on 3/4/2025. Pricing and RFP responses will be evaluated on 3/4/25. Pricing will be subject to refresh & contract negotiation prior to signature.
4. Do any of the facilities in this RFP have existing or planned behind-the-meter generation, including but not limited to, cogeneration, solar, wind, fuel cell, etc.? If so, can you please provide as many details as possible including installation date, fuel type, historic output, intended future output, etc.?
Not at this time.
5. Can you please confirm how changes in laws and tariffs should be handled?
We will review and discuss as a part of the contract negotiation process, if necessary. Capacity is discussed in the RFP for Group 2, and question 7 below.
6. Can you please confirm that “No RPS” refers to RPS being passed through, and that it only applies to group 1 accounts?
CSU self-assesses taxes for Group 1 only and is therefore exempt from RPS.
7. Under the fixed pricing group, can updates to PJM’s RPM Capacity auction results be passed through?
