DAVID M. REYNOLDS was appointed on March 23, 2017 by Governor John R. Kasich for a term ending May 1, 2025, replacing Rev. Dr. Todd Davidson. He had previously served as a Community Board Member, from September 30, 2016, through March 23, 2017. Trustee Reynolds was elected to the position of Chairman of the Board of Trustees in May 2021, and was re-elected in 2022 and 2023.

Mr. Reynolds, a private banking executive, currently serves as a Managing Director at JP Morgan Private Bank. Prior to rejoining JP Morgan, Mr. Reynolds served as national director of channel management and client acquisition for Key Private Bank from 2015–2023.

Before joining KeyCorp, Reynolds was Market Leader and Managing Director of JP Morgan's Private Bank in NE Ohio. Prior to that, Mr. Reynolds was director of Northern Indiana for Merrill Lynch. He earned a bachelor's degree in finance and management from Walsh University.

Reynolds is highly visible in the Cleveland community and has a passion for helping to educate at-risk children. In addition to serving as chair of CSU's Board of Trustees, he is chairman of the Board of the Friends of Ginn Academy, the only all male public high school in the state of Ohio, and past chairman of the Board of Karamu House, the oldest African American cultural arts institution in the country. Reynolds also serves as a board director at University Hospitals Cleveland Medical Center and the Great Lakes Science Center.
