










VPN Client Installation – Windows 10 – Quick Reference

CSU is using OpenVPN to create a Virtual Private Network (VPN). VPN is a network that uses the Internet to provide individual users with secure access to an organization’s network (in this case, CSU’s network). These steps may vary slightly between different web browsers (Firefox, Google Chrome, Internet Explorer, Safari).

Step 1	<p>On your home computer, open a web browser and go to https://openvpn.csuohio.edu</p> <p>Enter your 7 digit CSU ID number and password and click Login.</p>	
Step 2	<p>Download OpenVPN Connect for Windows.</p>	
Step 3	<p>Run the ‘openvpn-connect.msi’ installer that you just downloaded.</p>	
Step 4	<p>Follow the prompts on the Open VPN Client Setup Wizard.</p>	
Step 5	<p>Right-click the OpenVPN logo and click on the ‘Connect’ option.</p>	
Step 6	<p>Enter your CSU ID and Password in these fields and click Connect.</p>	
Step 7	<p>To disconnect, right-click the OpenVPN logo in the bottom right corner and click Disconnect.</p>
